

ATM & POS SKIMMING

Card data theft via skimmers and fake machines.

Skimming is a type of fraud where criminals steal your card data (from the magnetic stripe or chip) and your PIN without you knowing.

How it happens:

- Fake card readers on machines.
- Hidden cameras to steal PINs.
- Tampered or bulky keypads.
- Fraudsters distracting at ATMs.

How to stay safe:

- Inspect machine before use.
- Shield your PIN.
- Use ATMs in banks or well-lit areas with CCTV surveillance.
- Report anything suspicious.
