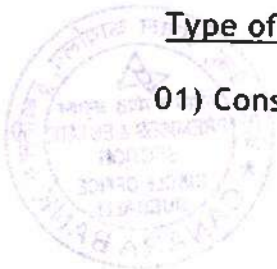

The eligible and interested architects, consultants, contractors, suppliers/ vendors and service providers may collect the "Document for empanelment" from the above office by paying non-refundable fee of Rs. 590/- (Five Hundred and ninety only) inclusive of 18% GST by way of cash or Demand Draft favouring "Canara Bank Circle Office, Hubballi" payable at Hubballi.

Alternatively, the document can also be down loaded from the website of Bank namely <http://www.canarabank.com/> and the document fee of Rs 590.00 in the form of Demand Draft favouring 'Canara Bank Circle Office Hubballi' payable at Hubballi, may be submitted along with the duly filled in application document. The document submitted without the prescribed fee will be summarily rejected. Applicants who have already paid Rs 590/-, while purchasing the application directly from the above mentioned office of Bank, need not enclose DD while submitting the filled application form.

The duly completed document in the prescribed format with all supporting documents shall be sealed in a cover and super scribed as 'Application for EMPANELMENT of (Category Name)' and shall be submitted to the above mentioned office of CANARA BANK on or before 09.06.2021 up to 3.00 PM.

Separate application forms are to be submitted for different categories.

GENERAL RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS TO THE INTENDING APPLICANTS

1.0. The empanelment of Consultants, Contractors, Suppliers and Service Providers, are proposed for the Civil, Electrical, Interior works and other allied works of routine nature in the Branches and offices coming within the jurisdiction of Canara Bank Circle Office Hubballi. Generally, the routine works of the Bank are awarded/procurements are made on calling competitive tenders/quotations from the empanelled contractors/suppliers. However, the Bank has the right to award the work/procure supply from any of the empanelled agencies, depending on the exigencies of the work and also opt for open tendering process for any particular work, depending on the nature & magnitude of the work.

2.0. This document consists of the following:

2.1. Notice inviting applications for empanelment of consultants, contractors, suppliers/vendors and Service providers.

2.2. General rules and instructions to the intending applicants.

2.3. Scope, cost wise sub-classification and eligibility criteria for each category.

2.4. Application format for empanelment.

3.0. The complete document as detailed above, complete in all respects, should be submitted by the intending applicants within the stipulated date and as per the instructions given in the Notice inviting applications. The details of the applicants and their experience shall be furnished in the prescribed "Application Format" only. Wherever required and if the space provided is not sufficient, particulars can be furnished in Annexure but such details shall be clearly mentioned in the respective columns of the Application Format. Applicant shall enclose latest copies of brochures and technical documentation giving additional information about the applicant. Each page of the document shall be duly signed by the Applicant or their authorized representative.

The checklist given along the application should be duly filled up and should be submitted along with applications. The applications without checklist are liable for rejection.

4.0. The Consultants/Contractors/Suppliers/Service Providers, who intend to apply for more than one category, have to apply for each category using separate application forms.

5.0. No costs incurred by the applicant in applying, in providing necessary clarifications or attending discussions, conferences or site visits will be reimbursed by the Bank.

6.0. Documentary proof with respect to the details furnished in the application form regarding eligibility criteria shall be furnished along with the application form. In this regard, copies of the work order and completion certificate and/or such documents shall be submitted. Incomplete applications or applications without proper proofs for establishing their credentials will be summarily rejected and no correspondence will be entertained in this regard.

7.0. If the application is made by a partnership firm, a certified copy of the partnership



deed, current address of the firm and the full names and current addresses of all the partners of the firm shall also accompany the application.

8.0. If the application is made by a limited company, it shall be signed by a duly authorized person holding the power of attorney for signing the application in which case certified copies of the power of attorney and the certification of incorporation, Memorandum of Articles of Association shall accompany the application.

9.0. The empanelment shall be made for a specific category as per the application received supported by documentary proofs. For different category the applicant has to apply using separate application form.

10.0. The evaluation will be based on the experience of the consultants/ contractors / suppliers/ service providers and their financial capabilities and may also include inspecting the works furnished by them for which, necessary co-ordination shall be made by them. Based on the details furnished and inspection of works, eligibility criteria, the consultants/ contractors/ suppliers/ service providers will be empanelled. Decision of the Bank regarding selection / rejection for empanelment will be final and binding and no further correspondence will be entertained. Only the empanelled contractors will be informed by post.

11.0. If, information and details furnished by applicants are found to be false at any time in future or any information withheld, which comes to the notice of the Bank at a later date, the empanelment of such applicant will be cancelled immediately.

12.0. Applications received after the due date and time is liable for rejections.

13.0. The consultants/contractors/suppliers/service providers having their office in the state of Karnataka will only be considered. The empanelment shall be valid up to three year from the date of issue of empanelment letter under normal circumstances provided there is no disciplinary/ de-empanelment clause raised against them.

14.0. Canara Bank reserves its right to reject any / or all the applications without assigning any reasons whatsoever.

15.0. MSE's (Micro and Small Enterprise) / NSIC / KVI etc. are exempted from paying the processing fee of Rs.590/- for which the concerned enterprise needs to provide necessary valid certificates / documentary evidence of the said work. For MSE's, Govt. of India provision shall be considered while evaluating the tender.

16.0. Firms should submit an undertaking (on their letter head) that they have not been "Black Listed" by any of the Govt. Authority or PSUs/PSBs duly signed by authorized signatory with company seal.

17.0. Applicant should be willing to supply and install the required items at uniform rates in all our branches in the jurisdiction of Hubballi Circle without additional / differential



freight charges.

18.0. When the misconduct of a firm or its continued poor performance justified imposition of ban on business relation with the firm or it's Blacklisting, this action will be taken after due consideration of all factors and circumstances of the case. Ban for a specified period of time may be imposed by The Bank.

19.0. Empanelment provides you the opportunity to participate in the tender process invited from time to time for various routine works. Empanelment does not provide a guaranty for getting any work assigned. The Applicant should be in touch with the Premises Section after the Empanelment Process.



EVALUATION CRITERIA FOR EMPANELMENT APPLICATION

As the process of Empanelment deals with the submission of documents and fulfilling the required eligibility criterion; the list of Empanelled Vendors will be made based on a score of 100 maximum points in 10 different parameters. The applicant, who scores minimum 40 points out of 100, will be considered successful, as per the following evaluation / scoring system.

in cases where quantifiable information is NOT available / provided, for calculation of points, following proportionate scale will be used and accordingly the points will be awarded:

The scores will be awarded on the basis of information provided, inquiries made by phone or email or similar means, feedback received from other counterparts and agencies, visits made and similar methods as approved by our authorities. This score may also be used for distribution of work in case of multiple firms are eligible by fulfilling the criterion.



SCOPE, COST WISE SUB-CLASSIFICATION AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR CONSULTANTS

A.SCOPE-OF-WORK

The scope of work for the **Architectural Consultants** include designing interior layout plans for the branch/offices of the Bank, providing the specifications of the materials, assisting the Bank in finalizing the contractor and supervision of the interior works ,if sought by the Bank. Some time the panel architects services will also be availed for planning, designing and execution of extension of Banks own buildings involving the approval for the same from the local Authorities.

The services of **Civil Engineering/Structural consultants** will be used for planning, estimation and execution, maintenance of Civil works of Bank's own buildings, measurement of carpet area of the Branch/office premises.

The services of **Electrical consultants** will be used for planning and execution of the electrical works for the Bank branches/offices including procurement of electrical equipments like Generators, UPS, Transformers and other allied items.

Generally, the routine interior works, Civil, electrical and air-conditioning works as detailed above are being carried out by the Bank's Engineers. The services of the consultants will be availed as and when it is required depending on the magnitude and specialization required for the project.

It is proposed to avail services of consultants from the approved panel for the interior works costing up to Rs.70.00 lakhs, Civil works costing up to Rs.100.00 lakhs, Electrical works & Air-conditioning works up to Rs.30.00 lakhs. However, the Bank has right to avail the services of any consultant from out side the panel depending on the circumstances.

ARCHITECTS

- Graduate/Post Graduate diploma in Architecture/Civil Engineering with minimum 5 years of experience in the respective field as on 31.03.2021. The Architects with specialization in Interior designing will be preferred.
- The Architect must have registered with the council of Architecture and have experience in designing and supervising interior works for the Banks/ Financial



Institutions/software companies with lighting details, electrical, data-cabling and Air-conditioning layouts.

The architect should have completed:-

Five projects each costing Rs.10.00 lakhs

Or Three projects each costing Rs.15.00 lakhs

Or Two projects each costing Rs. 20.00 lakhs during the last three years.

- The average annual turnover (from professional fee) for the last 3 financial years shall not be less than Rs.5.00 lakhs.
- Should be an assessee of Income Tax

Note :: The Architect who meet the other requirements but not exactly meeting any of the criteria in 2 & 3 will also be considered for empanelment but they will be allowed to quote for the works up to Rs.10.00 lakhs only.

CIVIL ENGG/ STRUCTURAL CONSULTANTS

- Graduate in civil/structural Engineering with minimum 5 years of experience in the respective field as on 31.03.2021.
- The Civil Engg Consultant with post graduation in structural Engineering with experience in repairs and rehabilitation of the structures will be preferred. They should have experience in planning, designing and supervision of major repair works including water proofing works of buildings. The Civil Engg Consultant should have completed:-
Five projects each costing Rs.10.00 lakhs
Or Three projects each costing Rs.15.00 lakhs
Or Two projects each costing Rs. 20.00 lakhs during the last three years.
- The average annual turnover (from professional fee) for the last 3 financial years shall not be less than Rs.5.00 lakhs.
- Should be an assessee of Income Tax

Note :: The Civil Engg/ Structural Consultant who meet the other requirements but not exactly meeting any of the criteria in 2 & 3 will also be considered for empanelment but they will be allowed to quote for the works up to Rs.10.00 lakhs only.

ELECTRICAL CONSULTANTS

- Graduate in Electrical Engineering with minimum 5 years of experience in the respective field as on 31.03.2021.
- Should have experience in planning, designing and supervising of electrical works like Office automation related Electrification works/LT/HT substation installation works generators/ motors/ UPS/ lifts/ Air-Conditioning/ conducting Electrical Audits or such



other related works of at least:

Five projects each costing Rs.5.00 lakhs

Or Three projects each costing Rs.7.50 lakhs

Or Two projects each costing Rs.12.00 lakhs **during the last three years**

- The average annual turnover (professional fee) for the last 3 financial years shall not be less than **Rs.2.00 lakhs**
- Should be an assessee of Income Tax

Note :: The Electrical Consultant who meet the other requirements but not exactly meeting any of the criteria in 2 & 3 will also be considered for empanelment but they will be allowed to quote for the works up to Rs.5.00 lakhs only.

Note:

1. In all the above categories of consultants, other things being equal, the consultants having the experience in the contract administration for government, PSUs and Public Sector banks and Financial Institutions will be preferred.

2. The firms /companies meeting the eligibility criteria and having the qualified personnel as detailed above can also apply.

SCOPE, COST WISE SUB-CLASSIFICATION AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR CONTRACTORS

A. SCOPE OF WORK:

The scope of work of **Contractors for Interior works** mainly involves erection of partitions, counters, paneling, false ceiling, cavity flooring, furniture and fabricated workstations and other allied works for furnishing of branches and offices of the Bank.

The panel of **Civil Engineering Contractors** will be mainly used for civil engineering works like earthwork, masonry, plastering, RCC, concrete works, painting, flooring, plumbing & sanitary, water proofing, demolition works, structural steel fabrication, woodwork (doors and windows only) and other allied works for branches, Bank owned residences and offices of the Bank.

The panel of **Electrical Contractors** will be mainly used for internal and external electrification, associated cabling, earthing, wiring for air-conditioners, UPS, liaisoning with Reliance Energy, Tata Power, BEST or other state electricity board for obtention of additional power, breakdown repairs and other allied works for various branches/ offices of the Bank.

The scope of work of the **Fire detection and alarm contractors** mainly involves supply, installation, testing and commissioning of fire detection and alarm system for various



branches / Offices of the bank.

B. COST WISE SUB-CLASSIFICATION:

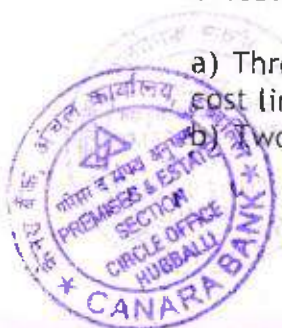
It is proposed to classify each category of contractors depending on their past performance, technical and financial capabilities of the contractor. The contractors empanelled under lower class/category will not be eligible to participate for the works of higher class/category. However, the contractors classified under higher class can participate for works under lower class.

The contractors empanelled under Class-D are allowed to quote only in the geographical jurisdiction of our Regional Offices where the contractor is stationed. The other class of contractors can quote for the works coming under the geographical jurisdiction of the Circle Office Hubballi.

FURNISHING

- The contractor who intends to apply for Class-D (petty works) should have minimum two years experience prior to 31.03.2021 in furnishing works including repairs/renovation/remodeling of partitions, paneling, false ceiling, Furniture's, counters for branches / offices of a Bank or financial Institution. He should have executed at least one single similar work costing not less Rs.10000.00 during the last one year.
- The contractor who intends to apply for Class- A, B & C should have the experience of successfully completing following quantum of similar works such as original works, alterations and renovations involving partitions, paneling, false ceiling, cavity flooring, furniture's, work stations, counters for branches/ offices of a Bank/ Government departments/public sector undertaking/central autonomous bodies/state autonomous bodies/financial institutions or other reputed firms during last 5 years prior to 31.03.2021:
 - a) Three similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the cost limit in the respective Class OR
 - b) Two similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the



Cost limit in the respective Class Or

c) One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the cost Limit in the respective Class.

- Except for Class-D, the contractors for other classes should

a) Be an assessee of Income Tax and should have registered with Goods and Services Tax department. Submit income tax clearance certificate or copy of the income tax returns and Goods and Services tax registration certificate with valid registration number.

b) Have well established work shop for preparing the furnishing/ furniture items

c) Have the average annual financial turnover of at least two times the cost limit in the respective class during last 3 years ending with 31.03.2020.

d) Submit Solvency certificate from Nationalized/ scheduled bank issued within one year for an amount equal to the cost limit in the respective category.

CONTRACTORS FOR CIVIL/WATER PROOFING WORKS

1. The contractor intends to be empanelled under Class-D should have minimum two years experience prior to 31.03.2021 in Civil Engineering works including all repairs in the building involving civil engineering works like earthwork, masonry, plastering, RCC, concrete works, painting, flooring, plumbing & sanitary, water proofing, demolition works, structural steel fabrication, woodwork (doors and windows only) for branches, residences and offices of any Banks and financial Institutions. He should have executed at least one single similar work costing not less Rs.10000.00 during the last one year.

2. The contractor intends to apply for Category- A,B & C should have the experience of successfully completing the following quantum of works such as original works, alterations, repairs and renovations involving civil engineering works like earthwork, masonry, plastering, RCC, concrete works, painting, flooring, plumbing & sanitary, water proofing, demolition works, structural steel fabrication, woodwork (doors and windows only) for branches, residences and offices of the Bank / Government departments/public sector undertaking/central autonomous bodies/state autonomous bodies/financial institutions during last 5 years prior to 31.03.2021.

a) Three similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the cost limit in the respective Class OR

b) Two similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the Cost limit in the respective Class Or

c) One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the cost Limit in the respective Class

3. Except for Class-D, the contractors for other classes should

a. Have well-established office in the respective centre with adequate engineering staff.

b. Be an assessee of Income Tax and should have registered with Goods and Services Tax department. Submit income tax clearance certificate/copy of the income tax



returns and Goods and Services tax registration certificate with valid registration number.

- c. Have the average annual financial turnover of at least two times the cost limit in the respective class during last 3 years ending with 31.03.2020.
- d. Submit solvency certificate from Nationalized/ scheduled bank issued within one year for an amount equal to the cost limit in the respective category.

ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS

- Contractors who intends to apply for Class-D (petty works) should have wireman license issued by the Electrical Inspectorate and have the experience of successfully completing repairs in the building involving internal and external electrification associated cabling, earthing, wiring for air-conditioners, UPS, breakdown repairs for branches / offices of a bank during the last two years prior to 31.03.2021. He should have completed at least one similar single work costing Rs.10000.00 during the last one year.
- The electrical contractors who apply for Class - A, B & C Should have valid A-class electrical contractors license issued by the Electrical Inspectorate and have the experience of successfully completed following quantum of works including original works, alterations and renovations involving internal and external LT electrification, panel boards, associated cabling, earthing, wiring for air-conditioners, UPS, liaisoning with local Electricity Board for obtaining of additional power, breakdown repairs for branches/offices of Bank/Government departments/public sector undertaking/central autonomous bodies/state autonomous bodies/financial institutions during last 5 years ending with 31.03.2021 as under:-
 - a) Three similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the cost limit in the respective class OR
 - (b) Two similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the cost limit in the respective class OR
 - (c) One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the cost limit in the respective category.
- Except for Class-D, the contractors for other classes should
 - a) Have well-established office in the respective centre with adequate Engineering staff
 - b) Be an assessee of Income Tax and should have registered with Goods and Services Tax Department. Submit Income Tax clearance certificate/copy of the income tax returns and Goods and Services tax. Registration certificate with valid Registration number.
 - c) Have the average annual financial turnover of at least two times the cost limit in the Respective class during last 3 years ending with 31.03.2020.
 - d) Submit solvency certificate from Nationalized /Scheduled bank issued within one year for an amount equal to cost limit in the respective class.



GLOW SIGN BOARDS CONTRACTORS

- Contractors who intends to apply for Class-D (petty works) should have minimum two years experience prior to 31.03.2021 in fabricating and supplying Glow Sign Boards at various branches or offices of Bank/Government departments/public sector undertaking/central autonomous bodies/state autonomous bodies/financial institutions. He should have executed at least one single similar work costing not less Rs.10000.00 during the last one year.
- The Glow Sign Board contractors who apply for Class - A, B & C should have the experience of successfully completed fabrication and supply of Glow Sign Boards of following quantum of works for branches/offices of Bank/Government departments/public sector undertaking/central autonomous bodies/state autonomous bodies/financial institutions during last 5 years ending with 31.03.2021 as under:-
 - a) Three similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the cost limit in the respective class OR
 - (b) Two similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the cost limit in the respective class OR
 - (c) One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the cost limit in the respective category.
- Except for Class-D, the contractors for other classes should
 - a) Have well-established office in the respective centre with adequate Engineering staff
 - b) Be an assessee of Income Tax and should have registered with Goods and Services Tax Department. Submit Income Tax clearance certificate/copy of the income tax returns and Goods and Services tax. Registration certificate with valid Registration number.
 - c) Have the average annual financial turnover of at least two times the cost limit in the Respective class during last 3 years ending with 31.03.2020.
 - d) Submit solvency certificate from Nationalized /Scheduled bank issued within one year for an amount equal to cost limit in the respective class.

Note:

1. Other things being Equal, the professionally qualified contractors and the contractors who have undertaken the works for Govt organizations will be preferred.
2. All class of contractors must be Income Tax Assessee. The contractors empanelled under Class-D also should get the PAN number from Income Tax Authorities and GST number from Goods and Services Tax Department within 6 months from the date of empanelment failing which, they will not be allowed to quote for any further works.



SCOPE, COST WISE SUB-CLASSIFICATION AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR SUPPLIERS/ VENDORS AND SERVICE PROVIDERS

The general eligibility criteria and cost wise sub-classification for the suppliers and service providers of Air-conditioners, Office furniture/ Modular furniture, Electrical Fixtures, Fittings and Equipments, UPS vendors, Electronic gadgets, Fire alarm, Burglar alarm, CCTV vendors, Fire extinguishers suppliers, Security Items (strong room door, TRTL/ FRRC safe, Safe Deposit Lockers) supplier vendors is as under:-

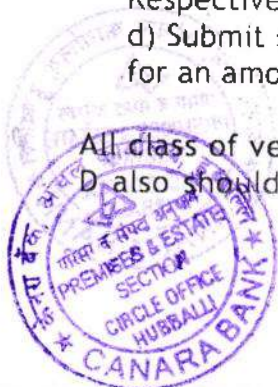
- The vendors applying for class-D should have minimum 2 years experience of supplying and servicing the respective product of worth not less than Rs. 75000.00 prior to 31.03.2021 and should have at least one single similar work costing not less Rs.10000.00 during the last one year.
- The vendors applying for class A, B & C should have minimum 5 years experience of supplying and servicing the respective product and should have undertaken work as under:-
 - (a) Three similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the cost limit in the respective class OR
 - (b) Two similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the cost limit in the respective class OR
 - (c) One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the cost limit in the respective category.

Cost wise sub-classification for the vendors in the category Suppliers and Service Providers is as under:-

- Except for Class-D, the contractors for other classes should
 - a) Have well-established office in the respective centre with adequate support staff.
 - b) Be an assessee of Income Tax and should have registered with Goods and Services Tax Department. Submit Income Tax clearance certificate/copy of the income tax returns and Goods and Services tax. Registration certificate with valid Registration number.
 - c) Have the average annual financial turnover of at least two times the cost limit in the Respective class during last 3 years ending with 31.03.2020.
 - d) Submit solvency certificate from Nationalized /Scheduled bank issued within one year for an amount equal to cost limit in the respective class.

All class of vendors must be Income Tax Assessee. The vendors empanelled under Class-D also should get the PAN number from Income Tax Authorities and GST number from



Goods and Services Tax Department within 6 months from the date of empanelment failing which, they will not be allowed to quote for any further works.

SCOPE AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR SERVICE PROVIDERS

PEST CONTROL SERVICES

- The service provider should have minimum 3 years experience in Pest Control service for all types of insects, rodents and snakes and should have completed servicing worth not less than Rs. 500000.00 and should have at least one single similar work costing not less Rs.100000.00 during the last one year prior to 31.03.2021.

The service provider should get the PAN number from Income Tax Authorities and GST number from Goods and Services Tax Department within 6 months from the date of empanelment failing which, they will not be allowed to quote for any further works.

LANDSCAPING SERVICES

- The service provider should have minimum 3 years experience in landscaping services of area not less than 10,000 Sft and should have completed landscaping work worth not less than Rs. 500000.00 and should have at least one single similar work costing not less Rs.100000.00 during the last one year prior to 31.03.2021.

The service provider should get the PAN number from Income Tax Authorities and GST number from Goods and Services Tax Department within 6 months from the date of empanelment failing which, they will not be allowed to quote for any further works.

PRIVATE SECURITY SERVICES AGENCIES

1. For empanelment or short-listing of Private Security Agencies (PSA), the following criteria shall be applied. For this purpose PSAs shall submit proof documents along with the tender and PSAs not submitting proof documents and/or not conforming to any of these parameters will not qualify for short listing:

- a) PSAs should be either registered companies or registered partnership firms for providing security guards services. PSAs should have the necessary clearance and valid License including that of the Office of the D.G.P. Karnataka to operate in the geographical jurisdiction of the Karnataka State.
- b) PSAs should have obtained a license in accordance with section 4 and 7 of the Private Security Regulation Act 2005, Karnataka Private Security Agencies Rules, 2008. Registration with Directorate General of Resettlement will be given preference.
- c) PSAs should have their own infrastructure for training their guards in Karnataka State.
- d) PSAs should have credible Supervisory and Training Infrastructure and network.



- e) PSAs should be an Income Tax assessee and should have submitted IT returns for the last three years.
 - f) PSAs should have audited Profit & Loss Accounts for the past three years and the average turnover of the PSA in the last three years should not be less than 20.00 Lakhs every year.
 - g) PSAs should have Registration under Shops & Establishments Act. PSAs should have necessary registrations with Labour Department and other Govt. Departments for compliance of all statutory/Govt requirements applicable to security agencies.
 - h) PSAs should have a valid certificate from ESI Corporation and should have been allotted with a code number by the ESIC.
 - i) PSAs should have a valid certificate under EPF & Miscellaneous Provisions Act 1952 and the PSA should have been submitting EPF contribution online.
 - j) PSAs should have Documents proving compliance of Minimum Wages Act 1948 and other Labour laws and rules.
 - k) PSAs should have at least Two telephone numbers along with Mobile, fax/ Email facility at their branch office/head office or in the jurisdiction area of Bangalore Circle Office and Bangalore Head Office and the office should be manned 24 x 7.
 - l) PSA should have minimum Three years of experience in providing Security Guards' services.
 - m) PSA shall not be owned or controlled by any director or office/employee of the Bank or their relative having the same meaning as assigned under section 6 of the Companies Act 1956.
 - n) The PSA should not have incurred loss in the last three years.
2. a) PSAs are required to furnish a copy of the Electronic Challan-Cum-Return (ECR) for EPF contribution for a Wage Month not older than two months prior to the tender opening date.
 - b) PSAs are required to furnish a copy of the previous "Return of Contributions" (Form-5) submitted to the ESIC or a copy Electronic Contribution History Sheet submitted to the ESIC in case of online contribution.
 - c) PSAs are required to furnish a copy of the past Wage Slip, not older than three months, of any of their employees deployed as a Security Guard with any Principle Employment.
 - d) PSAs will be required to produce all original documents kept in his office for verification by authorized staff of Bank whenever they visit PSA's Office for inspection of training infrastructure and other credentials of PSA
